TUITION BILL PAYMENT OPTIONS

- Do you know how you will be paying your bill?
UNH Manchester accepts the following methods of payment.
 - Personal or business checks made payable to UNH Manchester
 - Visa, Master Card or Discover credit cards
 - Tuition Pay Payment Plan. You may enroll with Sallie Mae at <https://tuitionpay.salliemae.com> or call (800) 625-0120. You may also enroll on campus at the Office of Student Accounts.
 - Veterans Benefits
 - Outside Scholarships

**UNH tuition bills are in electronic format and accessible through Webcat.
UNH does not issue hard copy paper bills, unless your account has past due status.**

PAYMENT DUE DATES

- Your fall 2009 Advance Registration bill is due in full August 8, 2009.
- A \$100.00 late fee will be assessed on your account on August 14, 2009 if payment is not made. (These dates apply to students registered prior to July 8, 2009 only.)
- **After July 8, 2009, course charges and fees are payable in full at time of registration.** Payments received after due date are subject to late fees.
- If you will not be attending your fall semester, please contact the Registration office to drop your classes by August 8, 2009 to avoid any additional charges. Notifying your instructor, not attending, or not paying your tuition bill will NOT relieve you of your tuition bill responsibility.

UNDERGRADUATE INCOMING, TRANSFER OR CHANGE OF STATUS STUDENTS
